Criteria Guidelines:

Criteria falls within medical, carer, community awareness, or individual achievement areas. The nominated person must have demonstrated a long term involvement or substantial influence or contribution to the kidney community or patients within the kidney community, for example:

- Those who have made an outstanding contribution to reducing the burden of kidney disease, e.g. health professionals, researchers, fundraisers/community groups
- Those who make a difference in the day-to-day life of those with kidney disease e.g. carers
- Those within the kidney community who provide positive role models that promote thinking patterns and behaviors leading to improved well-being e.g. donors, transplant recipients, volunteers
- Well-known Australian identities (most likely who have either had kidney disease or been affected by it) who have used their position to create awareness of kidney health, particularly the need for early detection and prevention

Includes doctors, nurses, consumers, carers, volunteers.
